Nephi Expansion

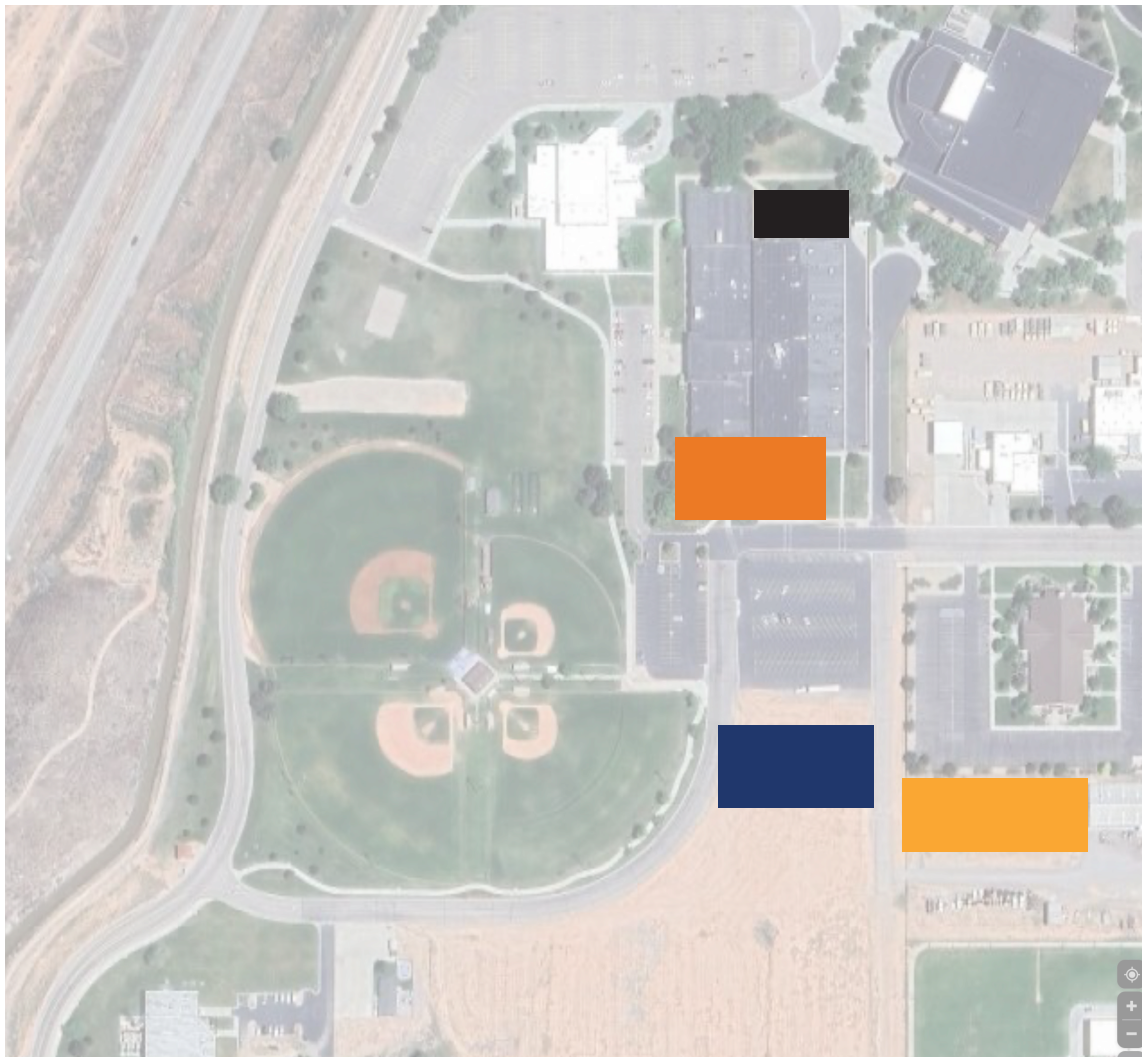

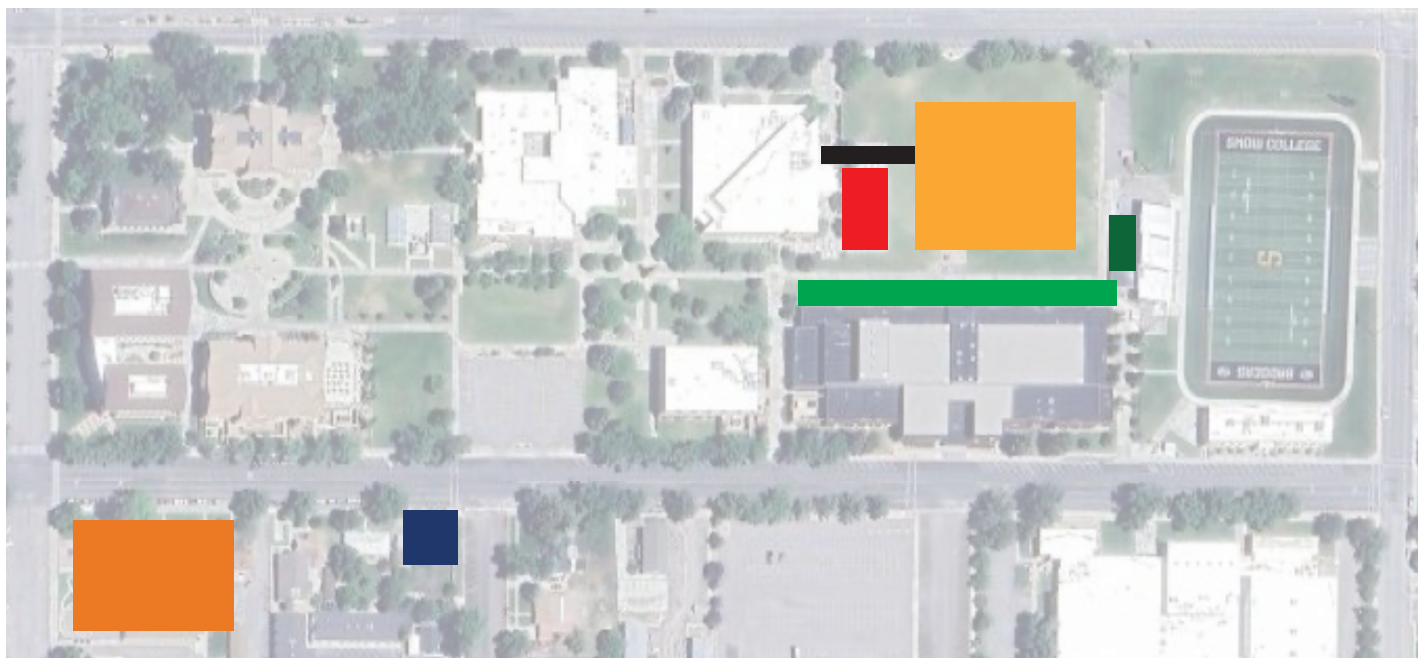

Facilities storage and parking

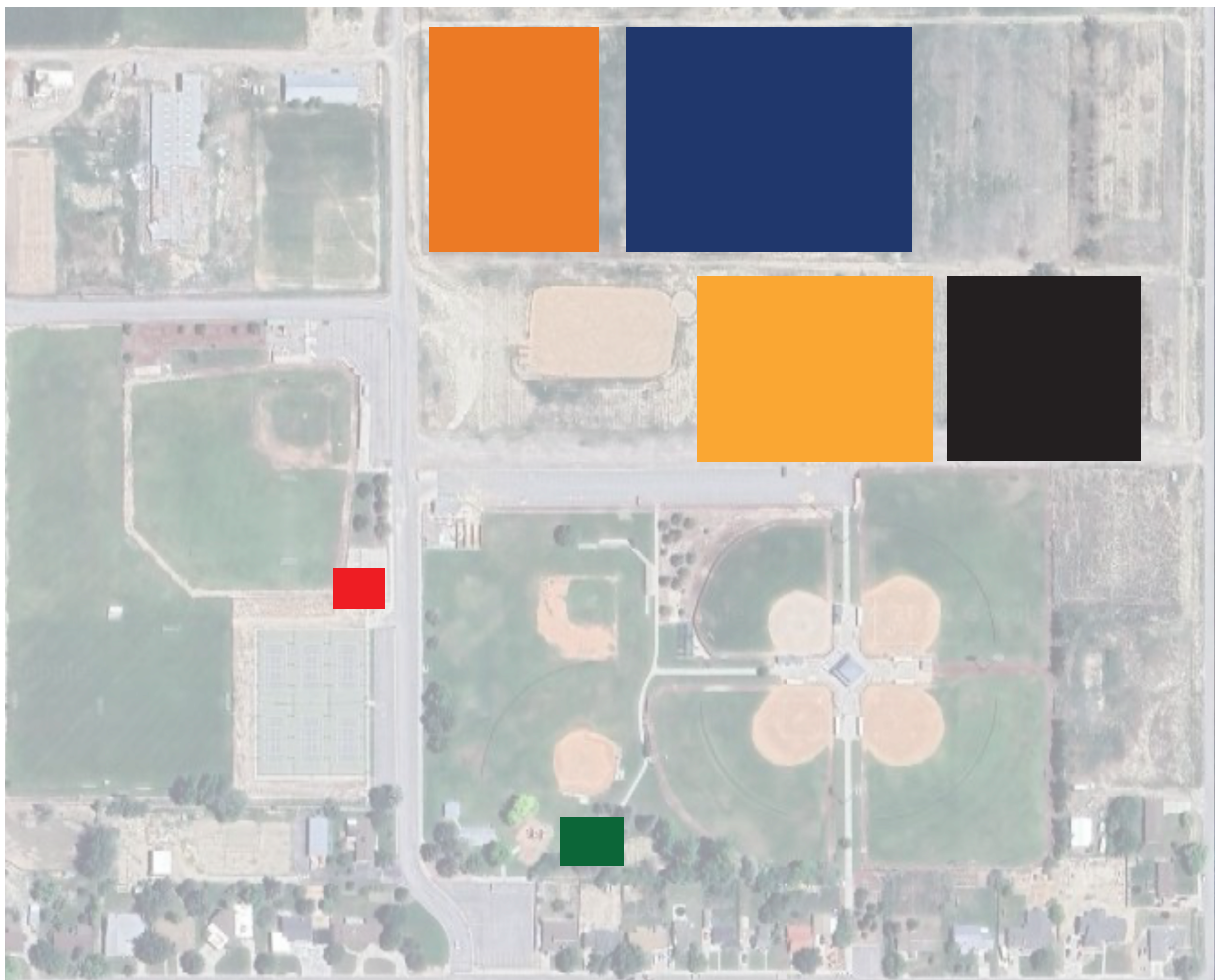


Eccles expansion on Main Campus will allow for expansion of Tech Ed program
