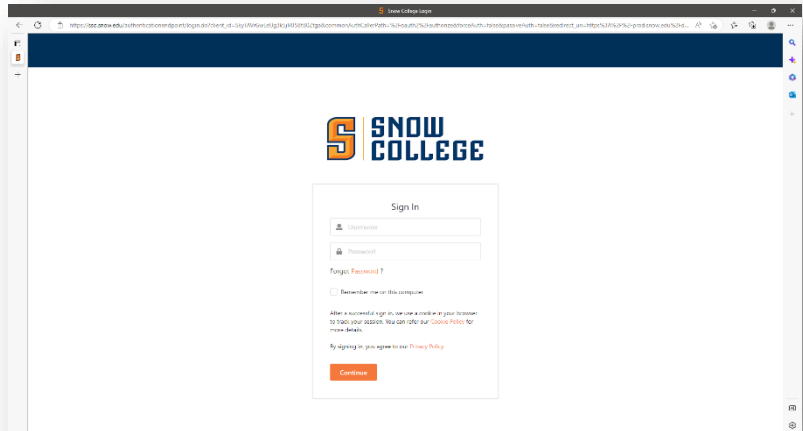


Student Guide to Snow College Course Evaluations

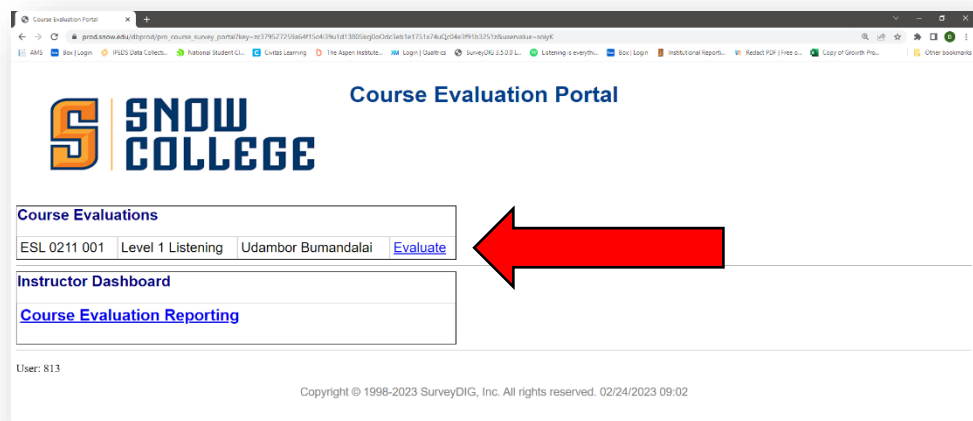
1. Use the following link to access your course evaluations. You can copy and paste this into any web browser.
